

Judo Saskatchewan Canada Winter Games Selection Policy

To be eligible each athlete must maintain good school performance and demonstrate a commitment to training at the club and provincial level. These subjective criteria will be reviewed and monitored by the Coaches and CWG Committee:

During year one (Sept 2008 – August 2009) athletes will receive 30 points for attendance at Summer Camp and 15 points for Winter Camp, 10 points for each mini camp. For competitions in Manitoba & Edmonton and at the Sask Open they will receive 20 points for first, 15 points for second and 10 points for third place finish providing they have at least two wins. For competitions within Province they will receive 15 points for first, 10 points for second and 5 points for third place finish providing they have at least two wins. Funding will be equal for all who wish to participate in these events during year one.

The above points will only count towards selections for the events in year two: They will not count towards final Canada Winter Games selections.

Any athlete may appeal a selection decision in writing to the Chair of the Canada Games committee who will review the appeal with the full committee and Head Coach and provide a written response within two weeks. If the athlete is still not satisfied they may submit an appeal in writing to the Vice President who will take it to the full Executive for final decision.

Selection:

During year 2 & 3 each athlete must maintain good school performance and demonstrate a commitment to training at the club and provincial level. These subjective criteria will be reviewed and monitored by the Coaches and CWG Committee:

Judo Saskatchewan will have an identified team trial for the 2011 Winter Canada Games. This trial will be held on the first week of December 2010. Athletes will have to qualify and be ranked in the top 3 in their respected weight divisions to be eligible for the Canada Games Trials according to the points scored in the competition grid.

Time Frame:	October 2009 to December 2010 (date of trial)
Eligibility:	Age - 19 – Belt Level for Jr Nationals at time of games
Weight Divisions:	Girls: -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, -78 +78 weight divisions
	Boys: -51, -55, -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100 +100 weight divisions

Change of weight Division: 75% of points will be transferred if an athletes changes weight divisions.

Deadline to declare Weight Division: November 01, 2010
